Description

This 2½-day review course and workshop is designed for interventional pain physicians, for a review, skills improvement or to assist in preparation for ABIPP Part I qualifications (if criteria are not already met) and Part II. It is the most in-depth, comprehensive, and individualized program available in interventional pain management, featuring maximum hands-on training with cadavers in a state-of-the-art facility and maximum ability to interact with other participants. Participants will experience a comprehensive and intense learning opportunity, focusing on interventional pain management techniques.

- Each workshop (cadaver station) is limited to a maximum of 8 participants.

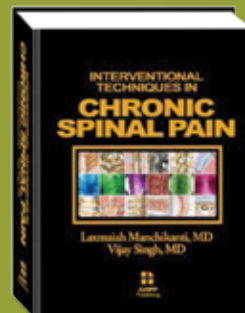
