*The Examination in Interventional Techniques. It will consist of three parts. Part 1 will be a theoretical examination. Part 2 will be identification of anatomical structures, equipment and x-ray equipment (C-arm). Part 3A will be a practical examination. Part 3B will be an oral examination.*

For the practical examination, two examiners from a pool of about 30 examiners will evaluate each candidate. Examiners who are known intimately by the candidate shall not evaluate candidates.

Successful completion of FIPP with satisfy requirements for American Board of Interventional Pain Physicians (ABIPP) part II examination.

## APPLYING TO TAKE THE EXAMINATION
