# Description

This 1 1/2 day workshop will include both lectures and hands-on work, using cadavers. Participants experience a comprehensive and intense learning opportunity, focusing on interventional pain management techniques.

This program is designed for **interventional pain physicians**. It is the most in-depth, comprehensive, and individualized program available in interventional pain management, featuring maximum hands-on training with cadavers in a state-of-the-art facility and maximum ability to interact with other participants.

Each workshop (cadaver station) is limited to **a maximum of 8 participants**.

The workshop is limited to approximately **70** participants with **10** cadaver stations.

Participants can choose the level of participation: Basic, Intermediate or Advanced.

C-arms and state-of-the-art equipment are utilized in this course. Participants are requested to dress in casual attire or scrubs. Leaded aprons and thyroid shields will be provided. **However, participants are advised to bring their own protective eyewear.**
