# An Algorithmic Approach to Epidural Steroid Injections

## **Indications (must meet 3 criteria)**

- 1. Radiculopathy or radicular pain and/or neurogenic claudication
- 2. Pain duration of 4 weeks
- 3. Inadequate or failed 4 weeks of conservative management

### **Effectiveness**

- 1. Three months of pain relief >= 50% relief, in conjunction with conservative management
- 2. Pain scale **OR** functional assessment

#### **Limitations**

- 1. Steroids Dosage limits (Triamcinolone 80 mg Betamethasone 12 mg , dexamethasone 15 mg) No methylprednisolone. Steroids almost mandatory unless allergy or contraindication.
- 2. CT or Fluoro except contrast allergy or pregnancy where ultrasound guidance without contrast may be considered
- 3. Imaging Minimum of 2 views (Final needle position and contrast flow should be retained)
- 4. Only mild or light sedation

#### **Utilization**

- 1. No multiple procedures
- 2. Two unilateral or bilateral for transforaminal. Maximum 4 per year per region.
- 3. Document medical necessity
- 4. Limited ICD-10 codes
